



Dear re-enactors,

The great re-enactment of 2020 had to be cancelled due to the spread of a certain virus. For June 2022, the organizers are preparing an event from Friday 17 to Sunday 19 June by bringing together a large number of international re-enactors.

The aim of this first contact is to look for the interest of groups for the June event, knowing that the number of participants is limited to 2000 people (re-enactors and accompanying persons: women and children).

We are waiting for your interest until **31 March 2022**? After this date, we will not accept any more expressions of interest applications. Applications will then be examined and a validation of registration will be sent. It will be accompanied by three documents: the individual registration form, the practical details and the rules.

[Health situation]: We would like to draw your attention to the fact that, depending on the evolution of the health regulations, the organizers will probably ask participants to present an official document certifying that they have been vaccinated against Covid-19 and/or to present negative PCR tests upon arrival at the bivouacs. In addition, in case of mandatory tests before and during the stay, the cost of these tests will be charged to the participants.

In order to avoid any risk of spreading the virus and to avoid possible quarantine, it is recommended to travel in individual vehicles and not in groups.

The organizers will adapt daily measures to eradicate the virus.

[Weapons]: It is the responsibility of re-enactors to comply with legislation on the import and export of weapons. It is also the responsibility of re-enactors to make the necessary arrangements. Information on this will be sent to you shortly.

[Horses and their riders]: Horses must be :

- be fitted with a microchip
- have a European passport
- present a vaccination booklet in order, including against equine influenza and against rhino for non-Belgian horses. These two vaccines must have been administered less than 6 months before the event. For horses from Belgium, it is strongly recommended that they are also in order of vaccination
- be in order of registration with the Belgian Horse Confederation for Belgian horses. For non-Belgians, an intra-community export certificate is required (to be obtained from the authorities), except for Luxembourg and Dutch horses.

We hope to see you motivated on the battlefield in June.
